our community.

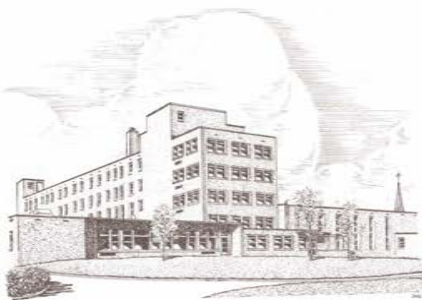
We have a wonderful
