enjoyed a nice vacation.

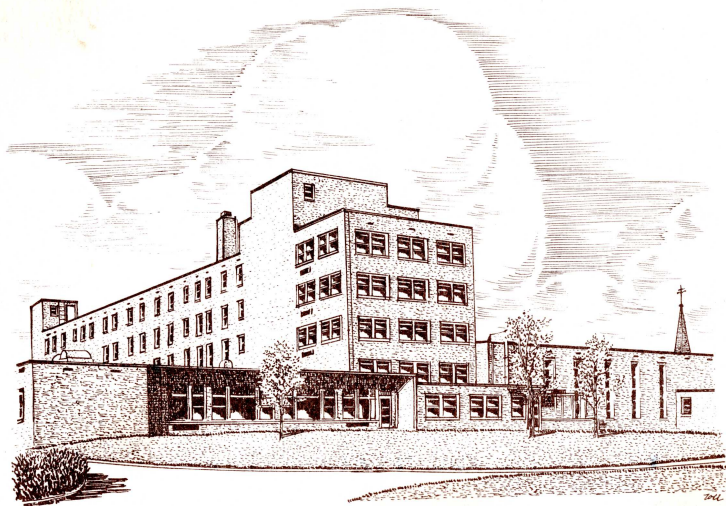
About 6 more
